SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

(FOR COMPLAINANCE WITH LABOUR WELFARE LEGISLATIONS WHEREVER APPLICABLE)

- 1. a) The contractor / agency should follow all Labour Welfare Legislators wherever applicable to protect the interests of the labourers /employee engaged by them to perform the works in BSNL.
- 1. b) The contractor / agency should take in to consideration all the Labour Welfare Legislations applicable and quote their rates inclusive of all statutory obligations cast upon the contractor/agency to protect the interests and welfare of the employees/labours. Nothing extra will be paid on any account by BSNL.
- 1. c) The contractor/agency will be fully responsible to follow all Labour Welfare Legislations and BSNL will not be responsible for any default/violation of Labour Welfare Legislations by the contractor/agency.
- 2) The contractor/agency should possess registration/ license from the appropriate Labour/ Provident Fund/ESI authority.
- 3) The contractor/agency should make payment of prescribed minimum wages to its workers.
- 4) The contractor/agency should ensure that all statutory dues of the employees are deposited with the appropriate authorities timely.

- ii) Vendors should furnish the correct HSN/SAC Code in the price Schedule. If the input tax credit under GST is found to be not admissible at any stage subsequently owing to wrong furnishing of tariff Head, then the vendors will be liable to refund such non-admissible amount, if already paid along with penalty if charged by the concerned authority.
- iii) In case the input tax credit which could not be availed by BSNL as per the quotes indicated in the price schedules by the vendors and subsequently at any stage it is found that input tax credit is admissible as per GST Rules, then the venders will be liable to refund the amount equivalent to such Duties & Taxes if already paid to them. However the purchaser may allow the supplier to submit necessary documents in this regard which may enable the purchaser to avail the input tax credit provided such credit is still available for the amount so paid as per GST Rules
- iv) The purchaser reserves the right to ask the bidders to submit documentary proof confirming the correct HSN/SAC Code where the code furnished against the particular tendered item by different bidders differs from each other or the same is found apparently not furnished in accordance with GST Rules.

3. EVALUATION OF BIDS

13.GUARANTEE AND DEFECT LIABILITY:

- (i) The guarantee shall be valid for twelve months reckoned from the actual date of completion. The contractor shall guarantee that all equipment shall be free from any defect due to the defective material and / or bad workmanship and also the equipment shall work satisfactorily with performance and efficiencies not less than the guaranteed values. The security deposit will be released only after the guarantee period.

- (v)In case the contractor fails to depute his representative within 24 hours of notification of the defect or fails to cause remedial action within reasonable time as decided during joint inspection, the BSNL may proceed to do so at the contractor's risk and expenses and without prejudice to any other right.

14.NOT COVERED UNDER GURANTEE:-

- (i) Consequential losses and damages.
- (ii) Parts subject to normal wear and tear such as electrical contacts.
- (iii) Failure of parts due to corrosive atmosphere.

- 19.
